Presenters and Workshops

Melissa Holcomb (she/her)

Melissa is a solitary practitioner inspired by the radical spiritual autonomy of neo-shamanism. Her path includes tarot, herbalism, Western Esoteric Tradition, and a fascination with the impact of the Neolithic Transition on the Western understanding of humanity's relationship with the more than human world. She draws on a professional background in health care to invite fellow travelers to de-stigmatize death as a healthy topic of conversation.

Vivian Gould (she/her) and Amy Rhea (they/them)

Vivian and Amy have been traditionally trained in Wicca and practice together as magickal partners. Together, they serve the land, the community, and the gods and give honor to the ancestors and other spirits of the dead who speak -- sometimes very loudly -- to them.

Kerry Lynn (she/her)

Over the past 25 years I have found spell crafting to be a constant joy, regardless of how my path evolved. I have done candle making, wand crafting, broom crafting, and more!

Tasha Lynne (she/her)

Having been a pagan for 20+ years and a Norse Pagan for 10, I have worked to expand my understanding of the old Norse arts, runes, and spiritual and cultural traditions. I have spent a large amount of my time working with death and healing deities and have held many informal classes surrounding them from time to time.

JoySparker has worked in animal care for over 20 years, has a degree in veterinary technology, and has been a credentialed veterinary technician since 2009. She has been a pagan since childhood. Her passions include helping people connect with animals and supporting the OSS community.

Ereshkigal's Death Cafe (1 hr) by Melissa Holcomb [Saturday 11:00 am]

This workshop provides an opportunity to talk about death while sharing refreshments "Our objective is 'to increase awareness of death with a view to helping people make the most of their (finite) lives'. A Death Cafe is a group directed discussion of death with no agenda, objectives or themes. It is a discussion group rather than a grief support or counselling session." - Deathcafe.com

Guardian Poppets for Samhain (1 hour) by Vivian and Amy [Saturday 1:00pm]

Join us as we discuss -- and make! -- Guardian Poppets, which will feature in Main Ritual and are intended to safely guide each person both into the underworld and back out again. These protective magickal partners can be used throughout the Samhain season and any time you are working with the spirits of the dead.

Sacred Broom Crafting (90 mins) by Kerry Lynn [Saturday 2:30 pm]

For this workshop we'll gather dried flora and fawn from our sacred land to craft our Brooms. We'll have supplies to decorate your broom and make it special to you. Please bring any crystals or other items specific to your path you'd like to use.

Death and All Their Friends (1 hr) by Tasha Lynne [Saturday 2:30 pm]

This workshop provides an overview of death deities. What are their origins? How do we interact and work with them? Through this presentation, we can get a look into why they are viewed the way they are.

Pet loss and Grieving (1 hr) by Sarah JoySparker [Sunday 11:00 am]

A discussion of different ways pagans experience the loss of pets and animals. This will be an opportunity for people to discuss their grief which is often censored or restricted. I will share advice and my own experience of being present at hundreds of animal euthanasia's and the resources I have from my professional training.
